Day 1: Arrive Vancouver

Arrive in **Vancouver** and meet your **Tour Director**. One of the most beautiful and cosmopolitan cities in North America, Vancouver dazzles with views of the Pacific Ocean, majestic mountains and a glittering skyline. Tonight enjoy a **Welcome Dinner**.
Meal: (D) Overnight: Vancouver

Day 2: Vancouver Island - Victoria

Today, ferry through the scenic Gulf Islands to **Vancouver Island**. Upon arrival visit the world famous **Butchart Gardens** to stroll among fifty acres of floral gardens, fountains and meandering paths. Then visit **Victoria**, British Columbia's beautiful capital. Enjoy a **Victoria City Tour** featuring the **Inner Harbor**, the imposing **Parliament Building** constructed in 1897 and views of the famous Empress Hotel. Enjoy a bit of leisure time to take in the city's turn of the century Victorian charm or shop in the downtown heritage district. Later return to Vancouver by ferry.
Meal: (B) Overnight: Vancouver

Day 3: Vancouver - Board VIA Rail - Overnight on Train

This morning, enjoy a bit of leisure time. Later enjoy a **Vancouver City Tour** including **Stanley Park**, famous for its colorful Indian totem poles, **Chinatown & Gastown**, Vancouver's turn of the century pedestrian mall lined with shops and restaurants along cobblestone streets. Dinner is included before heading to the train station. Later board VIA Rail's gleaming refurbished train, **The Canadian**, for a classic and memorable 2 Day & overnight rail excursion into the awe-inspiring Canadian Rockies. Explore the train before settling into your comfortable cabin in the **Sleeper Touring Class (Sleeper Cabin)** for the evening. The cabin features chairs converted to upper and lower beds for sleeping, a private toilet, a sink/vanity and a closet. Breakfast and lunch are included with this class along with exclusive access to the Park Car for panoramic views. See page 2 for more train details.
Meals: (B,D) Overnight: VIA Rail - Sleeper Car

Day 4: Canadian Rockies By VIA Rail - Jasper

The Canadian winds along the North Thompson River passing towering peaks and glacial valleys in a vast wilderness once only accessible by rail. Enjoy the views of the incredible passing scenery like Mt. Robson, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. Cross the Continental Divide into Alberta, arriving in **Jasper** in the late afternoon for a two-night stay.
Meals: (B,L) Overnight: Jasper

Day 5: Jasper National Park - Maligne Lake

Today, discover **Jasper National Park**, whose incredible scenery is comprised of carefully protected ecosystems, and is a photographer's paradise. The day begins with a visit to **Maligne Canyon**, a Jasper land-

mark. Next watch for wildlife as you drive to see the crystal blue waters of **Maligne Lake**, the largest natural lake in the Canadian Rockies. The rest of the day is at leisure to relax or explore Jasper. An optional cruise to Spirit Island will be available.
Meal: (B) Overnight: Jasper

Day 6: Jasper - Icefields Parkway - Banff

Today travel south along the **Icefields Parkway**, linking Jasper and Lake Louise, one of North America's most spectacular drives. Travel the road as it winds between snow-domed peaks and immense hanging glaciers; you may see elk, deer, bighorn sheep or bear. Stop to see the raw power of the **Athabasca Falls**. Later, ride in a specially designed **Ice Explorer** on the 1000-foot thick **Athabasca Glacier** part of the **Columbia Icefield**, one of the largest ice masses outside of the Arctic Circle. Later scale **Bow Pass** and stop to see turquoise blue **Peyto Lake**. Next, travel into **Banff National Park** & enjoy a brief **Banff Area Tour** including Mt. Rundle, Bow Falls, Tunnel Mountain & the Hoodoos. Then arrive at your hotel in the quaint town of Banff for a two-night stay.
Meals: (B,D) Overnight: Banff

Day 7: Banff - Yoho National Park - Lake Louise

Today, view two of the crown jewels of the Canadian Rockies. Stop to view spectacular **Moraine Lake** and the **Valley of the Ten Peaks** before visiting the Chateau Lake Louise, located within a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Capture spectacular views and photos of **Lake Louise** and **Victoria Glacier**. Then travel through Kicking Horse Pass into Yoho National Park to see the **Natural Bridge**, the remarkable **Spiral Tunnels** and cross the Continental Divide before returning to Banff.
Meals: (B) Overnight: Banff

Day 8: Banff - Calgary

This morning transfer to the Calgary and enjoy a **Calgary City Tour** to get a feel for this modern city. The tour features the **Calgary Tower** for a panorama of the city and nearby Rocky Mountains. Later take part in Calgary's most famous activity - the **Calgary Stampede**, which originated in 1923. The entire city gears up for this 10 day extravaganza billed as the "Greatest Outdoor Show On Earth". Tonight go cowboy as you have reserved seats for the **Calgary Stampede Chuckwagon Races**. Then, enjoy a **Farewell Dinner** with your travelling companions.
Meals: (B,D) Overnight: Calgary

Day 9: Calgary - Flight Home

This morning transfer to the Calgary airport for your flight home filled with wonderful memories of your **Canadian Rockies Via Rail Tour**.
Meals: (B)

Train Accommodations...Sleeper Plus Class - Sleeper Cabin doubles are accommodated in a bedroom with a window and two armchairs, which are replaced by upper and lower beds for sleeping. Amenities include a small closet, mirror, sink/vanity and private toilet. Breakfast & lunch are included along with exclusive access to the Park Car with it's lounges and 360-degree panoramic views. Singles are accommodated in smaller single bedrooms with a window seat that converts into a bed. Amenities include sink/vanity, mirror and toilet; single bedroom toilet is not accessible when bed is lowered. There are restrooms, and one (1) public shower in each sleeping car; each sleeping car accommodates 20 guests. Small overnight bag required. *The Canadian Train* departs Vancouver at 8:30 PM on Day 3 and arrives in Jasper at 4:00 PM on Day 4. The train schedule is subject to change & local rail traffic conditions. The Canadian Train is owned and operated by VIA Rail Canada.

DEPOSIT & FINAL PAYMENT
A deposit of \$300 per person is due with reservation form to secure reservations.
Final payment is due April 21, 2015.

CANCELLATION WAIVER & POST DEPARTURE PLAN

Payment of the per person Cancellation Waiver (waiver fee) guarantees full refund on all payments (including deposit), except the waiver fee itself, made for tour rates in case of cancellation up to the time & date of departure due to passenger's personal illness (medical documentation required) or death of a member of the immediate family (official documentation required). The waiver does not cover return transportation costs other than return air transportation utilizing original airline tickets. The waiver fee is fully refundable until 180 days prior to departure.
